) CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, the Oregon Board of Dentistry is authorized under ORS 679.025 and ORS 679.140 to license persons to practice dentistry in this State and to discipline licensees; and

WHEREAS, Ulrich G. Schockelt, D.M.D., ("licensee") is licensed to practice dentistry in this State having been issued license number D5558 on June 1, 1979; and

WHEREAS, based on the results of an investigation, the Board has issued a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action alleging that while treating patient JE on December 7, 2000 and April 26, 2001, the licensee failed to document "PARQ" or its equivalent in the patient's records after obtaining informed consent, the licensee failed to document a diagnosis of periodontal disease in the patient records or do periodontal probing although radiographs taken on December 7, 2000 showed evidence of bone loss and heavy subgingival calculus, the licensee failed to document in the patient's records a diagnosis to justify placing crowns on teeth #'s 13 and 14 prior to preparing the teeth for crowns, the licensee failed to document in the patient's records the name of the local anesthetic that was administered on April 26, 2001, the licensee failed to document in the patient's records that impressions were taken or that temporary crowns were placed on teeth #'s 13 and 14 on April 26, 2001, and the licensee seated a crown on tooth #14 with a defective mesial margin on June 5, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the licensee, aware of his right to a hearing with his attorney present to contest the charges against him and his right to judicial review, does hereby waive those rights and agrees to the entry of this Consent Order; and

WHEREAS, the licensee and the Board wish by way of this Consent Order to settle and resolve the above matter without further proceedings; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Licensee shall make a restitution payment in the sum of \$680.00 in the form of a cashier's or certified bank check made payable to the patient identified as JE. The check shall be sent to the Board within 60 days of the effective date of this Order.

2. Licensee is reprimanded.

3. The licensee shall successfully complete three hours of Board approved continuing education in record keeping, within one year of the effective date of this Order unless the Board grants an extension and advises the Licensee in writing. The course shall be approved in advance by the Board and shall be in addition to the Board's 2003-2005 continuing education requirement for license renewal. Licensee shall submit to the Board, within one year of the effective date of this Order, documentation of successful completion of the continuing education required by this Consent Order.

4. If the licensee violates any of the terms of this Order, the Board may, after Notice and Hearing, enter further disciplinary Orders including revocation therefore.

5. This Order is effective on the date that it is signed by the President of the Board.
